Postal Staff College, Islamabad, while working as Chief Postmaster (BPS-18), Sialkot GPO was found guilty of misconduct and inefficiency on account of concealment of facts, misreporting, cheating with the department and mis-appropriation of funds amounting to Rs.5,327.083/- from the treasury of Sialkot Cantt. HPO as per report of his controlling officer viz. Postmaster General. Central Punjab Circle, Lahore. Accordingly, an Order of Inquiry alongwith Statement of Allegations was issued by the Authority viz. Secretary, Ministry of Communications vide OM. No. 2-2/202 I -P.O-I dated 16-08-202 I and Ms. Khalida Gulnar, Additional Director General (A&F), Directorate General, Pakistan Post, Islamabad was appointed as Inquiry Officer under Rule 2(1)(c) read with Rule 9 of the Civil Servants (E&D) Rules,2020.

2. **WHEREAS,** the Inquiry Officer investigated the allegations leveled against the accused in the Statement of Allegations and after going through the relevant record and examining the witnesses etc. came to the conclusion that all allegations against the accused stand fully proven.

3. **WHEREAS,** the Authority viz Secretary (Communications) after examining the inquiry report and finding it in consonance with the provisions of the Civil Servants (E&D) Rules,2020 issued a Show Cause No.tice along with a copy of inquiry report to the accused officer on 28-02-2022. whereby he was directed to submit his written statement within fourteen (14) days of receipt of the No.tice. The accused officer was required to submit his

defense statement by 14-03-2022, however, he failed to submit the same within the stipulated time and submitted it on 1-03-2022 with the statement mentioning the biases and prejudice of the Inquiry Officer, coercion and pressure on witnesses, No.n-recovery of cash from him that cash was never short and he did No.t receive any funds.

4. **WHEREAS**, the Authority gave the accused opportunities of a personal hearing on 04-04-2022, 07-04-2022 and 22-04-2022 in terms of Rule 16 (6)(b) of the Civil Servants (E&D) Rules, 2020, however the accused failed to attend the hearing on the pretext that he has submitted his medical reports. The authority gave last opportunity of personal hearing to the accused officer on 28-04-2022 with an option to attend the proceedings via video link. It was also informed that if he failed to attend the same, the inquiry proceedings will be completed and decision would be taken in the case on merit / record as per Rule 16 (8) of the Rules ibid.

5. **WHEREAS**, the accused officer failed to attend any of the personal hearings. Therefore, the Authority proceeded further with the last hearing which was attended by the Departmental Representative. The Departmental Representative refuted the grounds of defense provided by the accused officer in his written defense and contended that the accused officer was provided with all the relevant record and reasonable opportunities to cross-examine the witness during the inquiry proceedings but he failed to refute the allegations leveled against him.

6. **THEREFORE**, the Authority examined the whole case thoroughly along with all relevant record and documents i.e inquiry report, show cause No.tice, defense statement of the officer and hearing the arguments of the Departmental Representative. The Authority has found that the accused officer is guilty of “colluding with co-accused officials for mis-appropriation of the funds. violation of departmental rules/regulations and willful mis-reporting and concealment of facts, which constitute “inefficiency” and “misconduct” under Rule 3 (a& b) of Civil Servants (E&D) Rules, 2020”.
