3. The recommendation to the post of Managing Director shall be made by following committee (As per MP- Scale Policy of the Federal Government issued *vide* Establishment Division's O.M. No.1/3/2020-E-6 dated 22-06-2020 as amended from time to time).

1. The compositions of the Selection committee will be as follows:

Minister in Charge / Minister of State (Where the Charge of a Ministry/ Division is held by the Prime Minister, the Selection board shall be headed by Federal /Minister of State/ Adviser to the Prime Minister /Special Assistant to the Prime Minister, as nominated by the Prime Minister).	Chairman
Secretary of the Ministry of Federal Education & Professional Training.	Member
Additional Secretary-II, Establishment Division.	Member
Additional Secretary of the Ministry of Federal Education & Professional Training or in case there is no Additional Secretary in the Division the Joint Secretary concerned.	Member

2. Following members may be co-opted on case to case basis.

The non-executive Chairman of the Board of Directors or a Senior member of the Board of Directors of the National Book Foundation.	Co-opted Member
One expert having domain knowledge to be nominated by the Minister, Ministry of Federal Education & Professional Training on recommendations of the Secretary, Ministry of Federal Education & Professional Training.	Co-opted Member
Head of Autonomous Body (In case of appointment in an autonomous body).	Co-opted Member

4. The Appointment of the Managing Director of the Foundation shall be made by Federal Government for initial period of three (03) years further extendable for a maximum period of two (02) years on annual (yearly) basis subject to satisfactory performance with the approval of the competent authority.

5. If any difficulty arises in giving effect to any of the provisions of these rules, the Ministry of Federal Education may make such order not inconsistent with the provisions of these rules as may appear to be necessary for the purpose of removing the difficulty.

6. Repeal :— The S.R.O 1210(I)2016 dated 8th November, 2016 is hereby repealed.
