DIRECTIVE

Islamabad, the 26th January, 2022

No. F. 6(3)/2022-LGE-S.—WHEREAS, a directive dated 2nd December, 2021 was issued to the extent that boundaries of existing administrative units and urban local areas shall stand frozen forthwith and no changes in the boundaries of aforementioned administrative units, tiers and extents of urban local areas shall be made till the culmination of the delimitation process in Sindh Province to carryout the delimitation process in smooth manner.

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Sindh amended the Local Government System vide amendment dated 24th December, 2021 and consequent upon the same issued corrigenda/notifications after 2nd December, 2021 whereby limits/extents of certain local areas are changed.

NOW THEREFORE, in view of above, the Election Commission of Pakistan is pleased to exempt these corrigenda/notifications issued by the Government of Sindh on or after 2nd December, 2021 till date from the purview of the directive issued on 2nd December, 2021 by the Election Commission of

Pakistan to avoid any complication and for smooth conduct of delimitation process. However, the Government of Sindh shall not further amend/issue any corrigendum/notification, changing the limits of any local area(s).

No. F. 6(3)/2022-LGE-S.—WHEREAS, the Election Commission of Pakistan under Article 222(b) & 219(d) of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan and Section-221 of the Elections Act, 2017 read with Section-10(2) of the Sindh Local Government Act, 2013, is charged with the duty to delimit the constituencies of the Local Government institutions;

WHEREAS, the Election Commission of Pakistan has issued schedule to carry out the delimitation of Union Councils, Union Committees and Wards in each district of Sindh Province vide Notification bearing No. F. 6(3)/2021-LGE(S) dated 28.12.2021, whereupon, proceedings have been started by the Delimitation Committees as per notified timelines and transfer of any member of the Delimitation Committee shall hamper smooth proceedings of the delimitation process;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under Article 218(3) of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, read with Sections-219 (6) of the Elections Act, 2017 and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Election Commission of Pakistan is pleased to direct that the officers appointed as Conveners/Members of Delimitation Committees, (*vide* ECP Notification bearing No. F. 6(3)12021-LGE-S dated 19-11-2021) shall not be transferred / posted till the culmination of delimitation process in Sindh Province.
