ORDINANCE NO. III OF 2022

AN

ORDINANCE

further to amend the General Statistics (Re-organization), Act 2011

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the General Statistics (Re-organization), Act, 2011 (XIV of 2011) for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Senate and the National Assembly are not in session and the President of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of the Article 89 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) This Ordinance shall be called the General Statistics (Re-organization) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2022.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of section 6, Ordinance No. XIV of 2011.**—In the General Statistics (Re-Organization) Act, 2011 (XIV of 2011), in section 6, in sub-section (3), for clause (a), the following shall be substituted, namely:—

(a) The following shall be *ex-officio* members, namely:—

- (i) Minister Incharge shall be the *ex-officio* Chairman of the Governing Council, Provided that if the subject is not allocated to the member of the cabinet, the Prime Minister may nominate a Minister to be the Chairman Governing Council;
- (ii) Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission, Member (Vice-Chairman);
- (iii) Secretary of Controlling Division;
- (iv) Chief Statistician of the Bureau; and
