S.R.O. 516(I)/2022.— In exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 of the Global Change Impact Studies Centre Act, 2013 (XVII of 2013), the Board of Governors, with the approval of the Federal Government, is pleased to make the following rules, namely: —

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules shall be called the Executive Director, Global Change Impact Studies Centre (Appointment and Terms and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. **Qualifications, experience and age for appointment.**—(1) No person shall be appointed or considered for appointment to the post of Executive Director unless he is in possession of a Ph.D. degree recognized by the Higher Education Commission (HEC) in a subject relevant to climate change with fourteen years professional experience or master's degree recognized by HEC, in a subject relevant to climate change with eighteen years professional experience.

(2) No person shall be considered for appointment as Executive Director who has attained the age of sixty-two years on the last date fixed for submission of applications for the said position.

3. **Disqualification.**—Without prejudice to anything contained in rule 2, no person shall be eligible for, or hold, appointment as Executive Director who—

- (a) is or has been dismissed or removed or compulsorily retired from service as a consequence of disciplinary proceedings;
- (b) is or has been by a court of competent jurisdiction convicted for an offence involving moral turpitude of corruption;
- (c) either at the time of appointment as Executive Director or thereafter during such appointment was not or is not a citizen of Pakistan; or
- (d) benefited from the National Reconciliation Ordinance, 2007 (LX of 2007).

4. **Manner of appointment and contract extension.**—Terms and conditions, initial recruitment, including advertisement of the position, scrutiny committee, selection committee appointing authority, submission of case to the appointing authority, contract extension, performance evaluation, termination of the contract, miscellaneous matters and underlying procedures, unless otherwise specified in these rules, shall be in accordance with the Management Position Scales Policy, 2020 as amended from time to time.

5. **Pay package.**—The person appointed as Executive Director shall be entitled to salary equivalent to MP-I Scale position in accordance with the Management Position Scales Policy, 2020 as determined by the Finance Division from time to time, with the approval of the Prime Minister.

6. **Tenure.**—The appointment of Executive Director shall be on contract basis initially for a period of three years and shall be eligible for re-appointment for one-year subject to maximum two extensions, based on satisfactory performance.

7. **Leave.**—The Executive Director shall earn leave in accordance with the Management Position Scales Policy, 2020.

8. **Applicability of other rules.**—In respect of matters not specified in these rules, the law, rules, policies, etc. applicable to the corresponding level of the persons appointed in the Federal Government's MP-I Scale shall be applicable.

9. **Repeal.**—The Appointment of Executive Director, Global Change Impact Studies Centre Rules, 2018 are hereby repealed.
