**THE CHIEF MINISTER GILGIT BALTISTAN**

**(SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) ACT-2021**

(ACT NO. V OF 2021)

*To provide for the Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of the Chief Minister  
Gilgit Baltistan*

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of the Chief Minister of Gilgit Baltistan for the purpose herein-after appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1 **Short title and commencement.**—(i) This Act shall be called the Chief Minister GB (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act No. V of 2021.

(ii) It shall come into force from the date 01-01-2021

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2 **Definitions.**—(i) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them that is to say—

- (a) **‘Order’** means the Govt. of Gilgit-Baltistan Order-2018.
- (b) **‘Chief Minister’** means Chief Minister of Gilgit Baltistan.
- (c) **‘Family’** means (the parents, the wife, legitimate and step children residing with and wholly dependent upon the Chief Minister.
- (d) **‘Government’** means the Government of Gilgit-Baltistan.
- (e) **‘Maintenance’** means in relation to a residence includes the payment of local rate, local taxes, electricity, gas fuel charges and the conservancy charges.
- (f) **‘Official Residence’** means the house reserved from time to time at GB Headquarter Gilgit for use by the Chief Minister.
- (g) **‘P.M’** means per month.

(ii) Words and expressions used but not defined in this Act shall have the same meanings as are assigned in the Order.

3 **Salary.**—The Chief Minister shall be entitled to receive a pay of Rs.270,000/- p.m.

4 **Sumptuary Allowance.**—The Chief Minister shall be entitled to receive a Sumptuary Allowance of Rs.150,000/- p.m.

5 **House Rent Allowance.**—(i) The Chief Minister shall be paid Rs.90,000/- p.m as House Rent Allowance.

(ii) Where the Chief Minister chooses to reside in the official residence, he shall not be entitled to claim House Rent Allowance.

6 **Dearness Allowance.**—The Chief Minister shall be paid Rs.130,000/- p.m as Dearness Allowance.

7 **Medical Allowance.**—(i) The Chief Minister shall be paid Rs.50,000/- p.m as Medical Allowance.

(ii) The Chief Minister and his family shall be paid actual expenses incurred on the medical treatment of the diseases (Cancer, Hepatitis C, Heart Surgery and Kidney/Liver transplantation from a Government hospital.

8 **Cell Phone/Internet Allowance.**—The Chief Minister shall be entitled to Rs.40,000/- p.m as Cell Phone/Internet Allowance.

9 **Utility Allowance.**—The Chief Minister shall be paid Rs.50,000/- p.m as Utility Allowance.

10 **Daily Allowance.**—(i) The Chief Minister shall be entitled to be paid Rs.10,000/- per day as Daily Allowance during attending of Government functions / meetings in the discharge of official duties undertaken outside his jurisdiction subject to production of invitation issued by the competent authority. The Daily Allowance shall be paid for the day of departure and the day of meeting.

(ii). The Chief Minister shall be paid room rent equivalent to two Daily Allowances during official tour if he does not avails Govt: accommodation (Guest House/Rest House).

11 **Equipment Allowance.**—The Chief Minister shall be entitled to receive Rs.100,000/- as Equipment Allowance once during the term of his office.

12 **Taking up/laying down the office Allowance.**—The Chief Minister shall be entitled to claim Rs.200,000/- once for taking up/laying down the office Allowance.

13 **Discretionary Grant.**—A sum of Rs.5000000/- (Rupees fifty lacs only) per year shall be placed at the disposal of the Chief Minister for making discretionary grants to the poor patients, orphan children, school fee of poor students and sports/charity organizations across the GB.

14 **Transport.**—The Chief Minister shall be entitled to the use of three official cars maintained at the Govt: expense including reasonable protocol vehicles. The general staff car rules shall apply *mutatis mutandis*.

15 **Death Compensation.**—The legal heirs of the Chief Minister shall be paid Rs.10000000/- (Rupees one crore only) in case of death during his term of office.

16 **Foreign Official Tour.**—The Chief Minister shall be paid Daily Allowance, room rent and fare charges in accordance with the prevalent Travelling Allowance Rules.

17 **Controlling Officer.**—The Chief Minister shall be his own Controlling Officer for purposes of traveling allowance including the journey undertaken outside his jurisdiction in the discharge of official business.

18 **Duty Free Car.**—The Chief Minister GB during his tenure as such may import or purchase out of bond one motorcar within engine capacity up to 3200 for his personal use without payment of custom duty and sales tax if exemption in respect of the same is granted by the Government.

19 **General.**—(i) All reasonable precautions shall be taken to see that the official residence, transport and furniture provided to the Chief Minister by Government are used with the same care with which a person's own property is taken care of.

(ii) All furniture and furnishings provided in an official residence shall be marked by the Works Department Gilgit-Baltistan for the purposes of identification.

(iii) When the Chief Minister occupies an official residence, it shall be the duty of the officer concerned of the said department to hand over charge of the furniture and furnishings in that residence to the Chief Minister or to a person authorized by him in writing according to an inventory to be drawn up and signed by such officer.

(iv) When the Chief Minister is about to vacate the official residence, he shall inform the officer concerned of the said department and shall arrange that the furniture and furnishings of the official residence are handed over to that officer according to an inventory to be drawn up and signed.

(v) The officer concerned of the said department may from time to time, inspect an official residence, its furniture and furnishings with the prior approval of the Chief Minister.

20 **Telephone.**—The Chief Minister shall be entitled at Government expenses to the use of three telephones at his office, two telephone along with internet facilities at his residence, expenses of which shall not exceed rupees thirty thousand collectively.

21 **Charge/Relinquish Report.**—The Chief Minister shall not be required to join / relinquish report while taking up / laying down the office.

22 **Personal Staff.**—The Chief Minister except while on leave shall be entitled to have such personal staff as may be sanctioned from time to time by the Principal Accounting Officer.

23 **Power to make rules.**—The Government may make rules to carry out the purpose of this Act.

24 **Repeal.**—The Gilgit-Baltistan Chief Minister/Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act-V of 2010 and GBLA Amended Act No. III of 2015 are hereby repealed.

*To provide for the Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of the Speaker GB  
Assembly*

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the Salary, Allowances and Privileges of the Speaker GB Assembly for the purpose herein-after appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:

1. **Short Title and Commencement.**—(i) This Act shall be called the Speaker GB Assembly (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act No. VI of 2021.

(ii) It shall come into force from 01-01-2021.

2. **Definitions.**—(i) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say—

(a) **‘Order’** means the Govt. of Gilgit-Baltistan Order-2018

(b) **‘Speaker’** means Speaker of Gilgit-Baltistan Assembly;

- (c) **'Family'** means (the parents, the wife, legitimate and step children residing with and wholly dependent upon the Speaker.
  - (d) **'Government'** means the Government of Gilgit-Baltistan.
  - (e) **'Maintenance'** means in relation to a residence includes the payment of local rate, local taxes, electricity, gas fuel charges and the conservancy charges;
  - (f) **'Official Residence'** the house reserved from time to time at GB Headquarter Gilgit for use by the Speaker.
  - (g) **'p.m.'** means per month.
- (ii) Words and expressions used but not defined in this Act shall have the same meanings as are assigned in the Order.
3. **Salary.**—The Speaker shall be entitled to receive a pay of Rs.250,000/- p.m.
4. **Sumptuary Allowance.**—The Speaker shall be entitled to receive Rs.130,000/- p.m. as Sumptuary Allowance.
5. **House Rent Allowance.**—(i) The Speaker shall be entitled to receive Rs.90,000/- p.m. as House Rent Allowance.
- (ii) Where the Speaker chooses to reside in the official residence, he shall not be entitled to claim House Rent Allowance.
6. **Dearness Allowance.**—The Speaker shall be paid Rs.130,000/- p.m. as Dearness Allowance.
7. **Medical Allowance.**—(i) The Speaker shall be paid Rs.50,000/- p.m. as Medical Allowance.
- (ii) The Speaker and his family shall be paid actual expenses incurred on the medical treatment of the diseases (Cancer, Hepatitis C, Heart Surgery and Kidney/Liver transplantation) from a Government hospital.

8. **Cell Phone/Internet Allowance.**—The Speaker shall be entitled to Rs.40,000/- p.m. as Cell phone/Internet Allowance.

9. **Utility Allowance.**—The Speaker shall be paid Rs.50,000/- p.m.as Utility Allowance.

10. **Daily Allowance.**—(i) The Speaker shall be entitled to be paid Rs.10,000/- per day as Daily Allowance during attending of Government functions / meetings in the discharge of official duties undertaken outside his jurisdiction subject to production of invitation issued by the competent authority. The Daily Allowance shall be paid for the day of departure and the day of meeting.

(ii). The Speaker shall be paid room rent equivalent to two daily allowances during official tour if he does not avails Govt. accommodation (Guest House/Rest House).

11. **Taking up/laying down the office Allowances.**—The Speaker shall be entitled to claim Rs.200,000/- once for taking up/laying down the office allowance.

12. **Equipment Allowance.**—The Speaker shall be entitled to receive Rs.100,000/- as Equipment Allowance once during his term of office.

13. **Death Compensation.**—The legal heirs of the Speaker shall be paid Rs.10000000/-(Rupees one crore only) in case of death during his term of office.

14. **Discretionary Grant.**—A sum of Rs.5000000/- (Rupees fifty lacs only) per year shall be placed at the disposal of the Speaker for making discretionary grants to the poor patients, orphan children, school fee of poor students and sports/charity organizations across the GB.

15. **Foreign Official Tour.**—The Speaker shall be paid daily allowance, room rent and fare charges in accordance with the prevalent Travelling Allowance Rules.

16. **Transport.**—The Speaker shall be entitled to the use of two official cars maintained at the Govt. expense. The general staff car rules shall apply *mutatis mutandis*.

17. **Leave.**—The Governor may grant to the Speaker during his term of office at any one time or from time to time leave of absence for urgent reasons of health or private affairs for a period not exceeding one month in a year.

18. **Controlling Officer.**—The Speaker shall be his own Controlling Officer for the purpose of Traveling Allowances including the journey undertaken outside his jurisdiction in the discharge of his official duties.

19. **General.**—(i) All reasonable precautions shall be taken to see that official residence, transport and furniture provided to the Speaker by Government are used with the same care with which a person's own property is taken care of.

(ii) All furniture and furnishings provided in an official residence shall be marked by the concerned officer of Assembly Secretariat for the purpose of identification.

(iii) When the Speaker occupies an official residence it shall be the duty of the officer concerned to hand over the charge of the furniture and furnishing in that residence to the Speaker or to a person authorized by him in writing according to an inventory to be drawn up and signed by such officer.

(iv) When the Speaker is about to vacate the official residence, he shall inform the officer concerned and shall arrange that the furniture and furnishings of the official residence are handed over to that officer according to an inventory to be drawn up and signed.

(v) The officer concerned may from time to time inspect an official residence, its furniture and furnishings with the prior approval of the Speaker.

20. **Telephone.**—The Speaker shall be entitled at Government expenses to the use of two telephones at his office, one telephone along with internet facilities at his residence, expenses of which shall not exceed rupees ten thousand collectively.



21. **Charge/Relinquish Report.**—The Speaker shall not be required to join / relinquish report while taking up / laying down the office.

22. **Personal Staff.**—The Speaker except while on leave shall be entitled to have such personal staff as may be sanctioned from time to time by the Principal Accounting Officer.

23. **Power to make rules.**—The Government may make rules to carry out the purpose of this Act.

24. **Repeal.**—The GB Legislative Assembly Speaker (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act-II of 2010 and GBLA Amended Act No. I of 2015 are hereby repealed.

(ii). The Minister shall be paid room rent equivalent to two Daily Allowances during official tour if he does not avails Govt. accommodation (Guest House/Rest House).

23. **Power to make rules.**—The Government may make rules to carry out the purpose of this Act.

24. **Repeal.**—The Gilgit Baltistan Chief Minister/Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act-V of 2010 and GBLA Amended Act No. III of 2015 are hereby repealed.

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**THE PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARIES GILGIT BALTISTAN  
(SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) ACT-2021**

(ACT NO. IX OF 2021)

ACT

*To provide for the Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of the  
Parliamentary Secretaries Gilgit Baltistan.*

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of Parliamentary Secretaries GB for the purpose herein-after appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows.—

1. **Short Title and Commencement.**—(i) This Act shall be called the Parliamentary Secretaries GB (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act No. V of 2021.

(ii) It shall come into force from 01-01-2021.

2. **Definitions.**—(i) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them, that is to say;

- (a) **‘Order’** means the Govt. of Gilgit-Baltistan Order-2018
- (b) **‘Parliamentary Secretaries’** means Parliamentary Secretaries of Gilgit-Baltistan;
- (c) **‘Family’** means (the parents, the wife legitimate and step children residing with and wholly dependent upon the Parliamentary Secretary.
- (d) **‘Government’** means the Government of Gilgit-Baltistan.
- (e) **P.M.** means per month.

(ii) Words and expressions used but not defined in this Act shall have the same meanings as are assigned in the Order.

3. **Salary.**—The Parliamentary Secretary shall be paid a Pay of Rs.160,000/- p.m.

4. **Sumptuary Allowance.**—The Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to receive Rs.80,000/- p.m. as sumptuary Allowance.

5. **House Rent Allowance.**—The Parliamentary Secretary shall be paid Rs.70,000/- p.m. as House Rent Allowance.

6. **Dearness Allowance.**—The Parliamentary Secretary shall be paid Rs.70,000/- p.m as Dearness Allowance.

7. **Medical Allowance.**—(i) The Parliamentary Secretary shall be paid Rs.30,000/- p.m.as Medical Allowance.

(ii) The Parliamentary Secretary and his family shall be paid actual expenses incurred on the medical treatment of the diseases (Cancer, Hepatitis C, Heart Surgery and Kidney/Liver transplantation from a Government hospital.

8. **Cell Phone/Internet Allowance.**—The Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to Rs.20,000/- p.m. as Cell phone/Internet Allowance.

9. **Utility Allowance.**—The Parliamentary Secretary shall be paid Rs.20,000/- p.m. as Utility Allowance.

10. **Office Maintenance Allowance.**—The Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to receive Rs.20,000/- p.m. as office maintenance allowance. If he avails official accommodation he does not entitle to claim Office Maintenance Allowance

11. **Official Transport.**—The Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to have an official car alongwith Rs.100000/- (Rupees one lac only) p.m as Maintenance/Fuel Allowance.

12. **Daily Allowance.**—(i) The Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to be paid Rs.7,000/- per day as Daily Allowance during attending of Government functions / meetings in the discharge of official duties undertaken outside his jurisdiction subject to production of invitation issued by the competent authority. The Daily Allowance shall be paid for the day of departure and the day of meeting.

(ii). The Parliamentary Secretary shall be paid room rent equivalent to two Daily Allowances during official tour if he does not avails Govt. accommodation (Guest House/Rest House).

13. **Death Compensation.**—The legal heirs of the Parliamentary Secretary shall be paid Rs.10000000/-(Rupees one crore only) as one time compensation in case of his death during his term of office.

14. **Controlling Officer.**—The Minister concerned shall be the Controlling Officer of the Parliamentary Secretary for the purposes of traveling allowance including the journey undertaken outside his jurisdiction in the discharge of official business. However the Parliamentary Secretaries shall proceed on official tour with the prior approval of the concerned Minister.

15. **Leave.**—The Chief Minister may grant to a Parliamentary Secretary, during his term of office, at any one time or from time to time leave of absence for urgent reasons of health or private affairs, for a period not exceeding three months in the aggregate during their term of office.

16. **Foreign Official Tour.**—The Parliamentary Secretary shall be paid Daily Allowance, room rent and fare charges in accordance with the prevalent Traveling Allowance Rules of Government.

17. **Power to Make Rules.**—The Govt. may make rules to carry out the purposes of this Act.

18. **Repeal.**—The GB Parliamentary Secretaries (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act-IV of 2011, GBLA Amended Act No. IV of 2015/18 are hereby repealed.

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**THE MEMBERS GILGIT BALTISTAN ASSEMBLY  
(SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) ACT-2021**

(ACT NO. X OF 2021)

*To provide for the Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of the  
Members GB Assembly.*

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of GB Assembly Members for the purpose herein-after appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows.—

1. **Short Title and Commencement.**—(i) This Act shall be called the Members Gilgit-Baltistan Assembly (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act No. X of 2021

(ii) It shall come into force from 01-01-2021.

2. **Definitions.**—(i) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say;

(a) **‘Order’** means the Govt. of Gilgit-Baltistan Order-2018

(b) **‘Member’** means Member of Gilgit-Baltistan Assembly;

- (c) **'Family'** means (the parents, the wife legitimate and step children residing with and wholly dependent upon the Member.
- (d) **'Government'** means the Government of Gilgit-Baltistan.
- (e) **P.M.** means per month.
- (ii) Words and expressions used but not defined in this Act shall have the same meanings as are assigned in the Order.
3. **Salary.**—The Member shall be paid a Pay of Rs.140,000/- p.m.
4. **Sumptuary Allowance.**—The Member shall be entitled to receive Rs.80,000/- p.m. as sumptuary Allowance.
5. **House Rent Allowance.**—The Member shall be paid Rs.70,000/- p.m. as House Rent Allowance.
6. **Dearness Allowance.**—The Member shall be paid Rs.70,000/- p.m as Dearness Allowance
7. **Medical Allowance.**—(i) The Member shall be paid Rs.30,000/- p.m. as Medical Allowance
- (ii) The Member and his family shall be paid actual expenses incurred on the medical treatment of the diseases (Cancer, Hepatitis C, Heart Surgery and Kidney/Liver transplantation from a Government hospital.
8. **Cell Phone/Internet Allowance.**—The Member shall be entitled to Rs.20,000/- p.m. as Cell phone/Internet allowance.
9. **Utility Allowance.**—The Member shall be paid Rs.20,000/- p.m. as Utility Allowance.
10. **Office Maintenance Allowance.**—The Member shall be entitled to receive Rs.20,000/- p.m. as office maintenance allowance.
11. **Conveyance Allowance.**—The Member shall be paid Rs.15,000/- p.m. as Conveyance Allowance.

12. **Official Transport.**—The Chairman Standing Committee shall be entitled to have an official car alongwith Rs.100000/- (Rupees one lac only) p.m as Maintenance/Fuel Allowance. The Chairman shall not be entitled to the Conveyance Allowance per month as mentioned in Section-11 once car is allotted and placed at his disposal.

13. **Free Travel Allowance.**—The Member shall be paid Rs.200000/- (Rupees two lacs only) per year as Free Travel Allowance.

14. **Daily Allowance.**—(i) The Member shall be entitled to be paid Rs.7,000/- as Daily Allowance per day during session, Meeting of House Committees, Government functions / meetings in the discharge of official duties undertaken outside their jurisdiction subject to production of invitation issued by the competent authority. The Daily Allowance shall be paid for the day of departure and the day of meeting.

(ii) The Member shall be paid room rent allowance equivalent to two daily allowances during official tour/duty if he does not avails Govt. accommodation (Rest/Guest Houses etc).

15. **Controlling Officer.**— The Secretary/PAO GB Assembly Secretariat shall be the Controlling Officer of Members for the purpose of travelling allowances including the journey undertaken outside their jurisdiction in the discharge of their official duties.

16. **Death Compensation.**—The legal heirs of the Member shall be paid Rs.10000000/- (Rupees one crore only) as one time compensation in case of his death during his term of office

17. **Foreign Official Tour.**—The Member shall be paid daily allowance, room rent and fare charges in accordance with the prevalent Traveling Allowance Rules of Government.

18. **Opposition Leader.**—The Opposition Leader GB Assembly shall be entitled to the salary, allowances and privileges as are admissible to a Minister of Gilgit Baltistan. The Speaker shall be the Controlling Officer of the Opposition Leader for the purposes of traveling allowance including the journey undertaken outside his jurisdiction in the discharge of official business, However the Opposition Leader shall proceed on the official tour with the prior approval of the Speaker GB Assembly.

19. **Power to Make Rules.**—The Govt. may make rules to carry out the purposes of this Act.

20. **Repeal.**—The GB Legislative Assembly (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of Members) Act-IV of 2010, GBLA Amended Acts No. V of 2015/18 are hereby repealed.
