No. F. 24(63)/2022-Legis.—The following Act of *Majlis-e-Shoora* (Parliament) received the assent of the President on 2nd November, 2022 and is hereby published for general information:-

ACT NO. XXXI OF 2022

An Act further to amend the National Assembly Secretariat Employees Act, 2018

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the National Assembly Secretariat Employees Act, 2018 (Act No. VII of 2018) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as under:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) This Act shall be called the National Assembly Secretariat Employees (Amendment) Act, 2022.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of section 6, Act VII of 2018.**—In the National Assembly Secretariat Employees Act, 2018 (VII of 2018), in section 6, in sub-section (1), in clause (c) for the full stop at the end a colon shall be substituted and thereafter the following proviso shall be added, namely:—

“Provided that in case of inability of the Federal Public Service Commission to recommend persons for initial appointment to the Posts in BPS-16 to BPS-19 on the requisition of the National Assembly Secretariat for such appointments within six months of receipt of the requisition, the Speaker may withdraw the requisition from the Federal Public Service Commission and make appointments against such posts through an open advertisement and after a selection process on the recommendations of the Departmental Selection Committee.”
