WHEREAS, you, PC-3615 Raja Altaf Ahmed, Asstt. CAO, GHQ, Rawalpindi were proceeded against under Government Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 1973, hereafter to be referred as Rules, on account of misconduct. The charges leveled against you, are as follows :-

- You have added fictitious amount of Rs. 116,791/- in your self medicine memos and Rs. 4,370/- in your wife's medicine memos as verified by M/s. Abid Pharmacy.

2. AND WHEREAS, the undersigned, being Authorized Officer, under Rule 2(3) Government Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 1973 has decided in terms of Rule 5(1) (iii) of *ibid* rules that it is not necessary to have an inquiry for the above charges and misconduct through Officer or Inquiry Committee.

3. THEREFORE, you, PC-3615 Raja Altaf Ahmed, Asstt. CAO were served with Show Cause Notice bearing No. 4/46/CAO/D-5/2017, dated 17th January, 2020 and you were directed to Show Cause within 14 days of the receipt of said Notice as to why the major penalty of dismissal from service should not be imposed on you under the Rules. It was mentioned that in case of non receipt of any written defence within the stipulated time period (from receipt of notice), it will be assumed that you have no explanation to offer in your defence and the charges leveled against you will be decided *ex-parte* on the basis of the evidences available on the record. You were also directed to state, if you desired to be heard in person by the Authorized Officer.

4. AND WHEREAS, you, Raja Altaf Ahmed, Asstt. CAO, were given personal hearing by the undersigned being Authorized Officer (designated by the Authority) on 25th February, 2020.

5. AND WHEREAS, complete record, reply to Show Cause Notice under Rule 6-A (2) of the *ibid* rules and proceedings of the personal hearing were perused in detail. It is established that the charges leveled against you in Show Cause Notice dated 17th January, 2020, stand proved against you beyond any doubt. In response to the Show Cause Notice and during the course of personal hearing, you failed to come up with fresh grounds in rebuttal of the charges already established against you. Rather your persistent denial and evasive replies concerning the overwriting on memos and tempering of bills are enough proof of your involvement in this forgery with clear incriminating evidence on record.

6. AND WHEREAS, being the Authorized Officer, under the provision of Rule 5(1) (iv) of *ibid* rules, the undersigned has decided to impose the minor penalty of "Withholding of annual increment for one year with non-recurring effect" on you, Raja Altaf Ahmed, Asstt. CAO.

7. You, Raja Altaf Ahmed, Asstt. CAO have right of appeal to the Appellate Authority for review of above stated decision within a period of 30 days from the date of communication of this notification, as prescribed under Rule 5(4) of Civil Servants (Appeals) Rules, 1977.
