This inoculum can be applied to the field directly or can be packed in polythene bags. This inoculum can also develop resistance in plants against pests and plant pathogens.

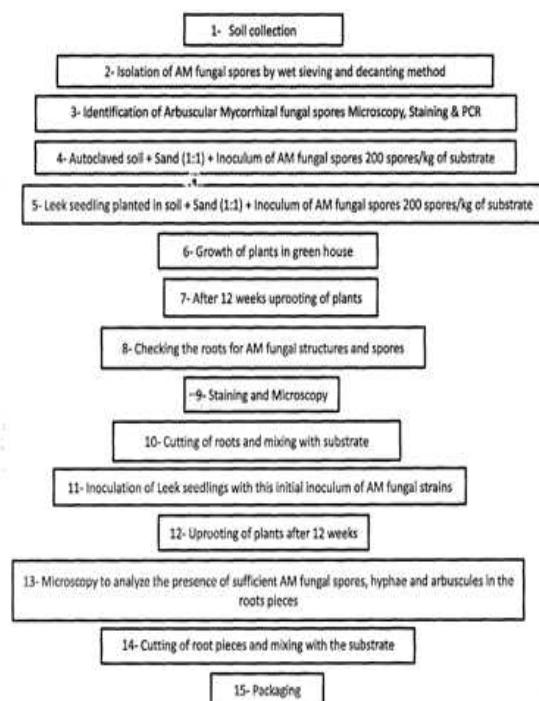


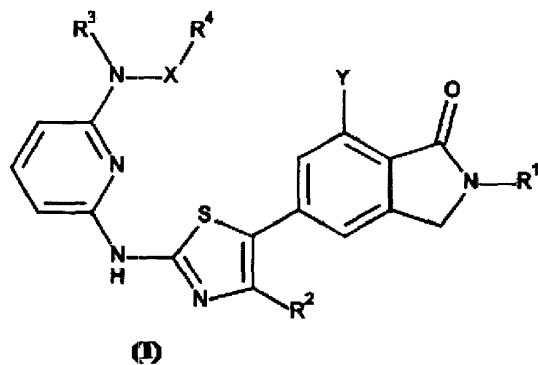
