2. WHEREAS, a Charge Sheet alongwith Statement of Allegations dated 16th April, 2015 was issued to the accused officer under Government Servants (E&D) Rules, 1973 by appointing Mrs. Fouzia Suleman, Dy. Postmaster General (Admn.) Central Punjab Circle, Lahore as Inquiry Officer to conduct inquiry in to the allegations.

3. WHEREAS, the Inquiry Officer investigated the allegations leveled against the accused in the Statement of Allegations and after going through the relevant record, examining the witnesses *etc*, came to the conclusion that all the allegations leveled against the accused stand proved.

4. WHEREAS, after considering the finding of the Inquiry Officer alongwith other relevant records, the accused officer was served with a Show Cause Notice dated 12th April, 2016 together with the copy of Inquiry Report, asking her to show cause within ten (10) days as to why one or more of the penalties including the major penalty of dismissal from service as prescribed under Rule 4 (1) of Government Servants (E&D) Rules, 1973, may not be imposed upon her. She was also offered to be heard in person.

5. AND WHEREAS, in response to Show Cause Notice, Ms. Huma Kanwal, submitted her written defense reply in which he failed to refute the charges leveled against her. She was also granted personal hearing on 15th August, 2016 during which she denied the allegations but could not prove herself innocent by producing valid evidences. Thus the charges of "Inefficiency" and "Misconduct" are established against her.

6. THEREFORE, the Authorized Officer in exercise of the powers vested in him under Rule 5(1)(iv) read with Rule 3 of the Government Servants (E&D) Rules, 1973, awarded

minor penalty of "Stoppage of Increment for two years without future effect" as prescribed in Rule 4 (1) of the said rules, upon Ms. Huma Kanwal, a BPS-17 officer of Postal Group, with effect from 9th March, 2017.

7. AND WHEREAS, aggrieved from the decision of the Authorized Officer, Ms. Huma Kanwal preferred departmental appeal dated 12th April, 2017 to the Authority. The Authority after going through the case, contentions of the appellant in her appeal as well as in the statement recorded during personal hearing dated 12th November, 2019 and other facts on record, has reached the conclusion that the allegations leveled against her were proved to some extent during the course of inquiry. However, the officer was on her first field posting and her performance is satisfactory.

8. THEREFORE, in view of the above, the Secretary Ministry of Postal Services in exercise of the powers of the Authority accepted the appeal of the appellate and *set aside* the order of punishment of stoppage of increment for two years imposed upon the appellant by the Authorized Officer *vide* Notification dated 9th March, 2017.
