5. The Authorized Officer informed that in light of the inquiry report, a Show Cause Notice dated 23rd September, 2019 was issued to the Accused officer under Rule-5 (iii) (b) of the Government Servants (E&D) Rules, 1973 giving him a reasonable opportunity of showing cause against the action proposed to taken and the grounds of the action, within seven (7) days of the issuance of that notice as to why one or more major penalties including major penalty "Dismissal from Service" may not be imposed upon him as prescribed under Rules 4(1)(b)(iv) of the said rules.

6. In response to Show Cause Notice, Mr. Adeel Sikander Yousafani, IRO send his reply through email dated 30th September, 2019 that due to following reasons, he could not resume his duty after expiry of leave on 15th September, 2018:-

- (i) The only reason for *ex*-Pakistan leave was to specialise in tax which started from Master of Management and Professional Accounting (MMPA) from University of Toronto and CA/CPA program. However, as a part of requirement to specialize in Tax with CPA designation, he got enrolled in CICA In-Depth Tax Program (equivalent to Master in Tax) with PA Ontario with expected graduate in September, 2020. As he was in the Middle of CICA In-Depth program, he could not resume his duties as IRO after expiry of leave as of 15th September, 2019.
- (ii) Besides his academic commitments, he had some family/personal commitments for which he could not leave Canada. For Instance, his elder son was in grade 4 at that time and his wife had some other professional commitments in Canada. Thus, it was not feasible for him to leave his family alone in Canada.
- (iii) He has almost more than 10 years of service in FBR with unblemished record and this is the first occasion he remained absent.

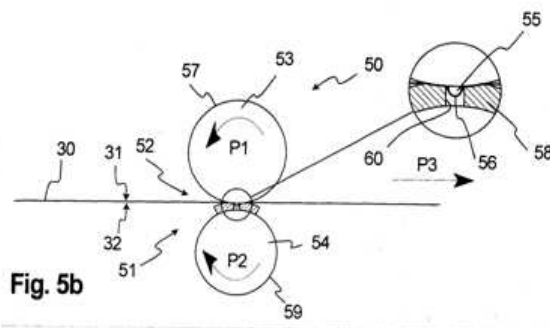
