No. 1(30)2015-SEZ.—Pursuant of the Section 3(n) read with Section 6(b) and Section 7(4) of the Special Economic Zones Act, 2012 (XX of 2012), the Board of Approval, (BOA) is pleased to approve the following zone applications received from the respective provincial SEZAs and to grant the status and notify as Special Economic Zones as per below given details:-

2. This notification is subject to the following conditions; and violation of any or all of these conditions, partly or wholly, shall lead to withdraw/revoke the notification of that SEZ with immediate effect.

- i. Construction of the Zone shall commence within 6 months from the date of this notification and each Developer will share with respective SEZA and the Secretariat of Approvals Committee / BOA the development progress of its respective Zone as per the submitted Master Plan and Execution Plan developed in Primavera/MS Project, on quarterly basis;
- ii. No change shall be made in the contents of the approved zone applications without prior approval of BOA;
- iii. Development and operations of the Zone shall be as per Master Plan submitted with the approved zone application;
- iv. Till the approval of the Development Agreement and/or constitution of the SEZ Committees, no Zone Developer will be entitled to sell/lease any Industrial/commercial plot or sign or intend to sign an MOU or agreement or any such instrument conditionally or unconditionally to sell/lease any such plot to any investor/enterprise or any other party;

- v. Zone Enterprises shall only be admitted into the Zone, after the approval of the respective SEZ Committee as provided under Section 23 of the SEZ Act 2012;
- vi. At the time of consideration of a Zone Enterprise entry application by the SEZ Committee, the respective Developer shall undertake to ensure provision of utilities to that Zone Enterprise, if admitted in the SEZ, as per the requirement and timeframe stated in its Zone Enterprise entry application;
- vii. Zone Developers shall at all time keep a clear title of the land or leasehold rights, that should be free from all encumbrances;
- viii. Zone Developers shall unconditionally comply with all the instructions/regulations/SPOs/Circulars/clarification etc., issued by the respective Provincial SEZA, Federal Board of Investment (BOI), being Secretariat of the Approvals Committee and BOA, as and when required to advance the objectives of the SEZ Act 2012;
- ix. The cost of utilities if any, for the private zones, till zero point, shall be borne by the respective Zone Developers;
- x. All conditions mentioned in the EPA certificate provided with the zone application or other requirements mentioned from time to time by the respective Environmental Protection Agency will be adhered by the Zone Developer in letter and spirit;
- xi. The Federal BOI, being Secretariat of the Approvals Committee and BOA, or respective SEZA may, at any time, by notice in writing require any director, officer and member of the Developer or respective Zone Enterprise, in general or in particular to furnish bi-annual reports containing any information relating to their project within the time specified therein or such further time as the BOI or respective SEZA may allow, with any statement or information and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing power, may call for information, at such intervals as the Federal BOI or respective SEZA may deem necessary;
- xii. Quantum of processing fee, if any, for zone enterprises entry applications shall be charged from prospective Zone Enterprises only after approval from the Board of Approvals;
- xiii. Developers and enterprises housed in the zone after the date of Notification of SEZ, regardless of claiming and expiry of incentives available under the SEZ Act 2012, shall be bound to adhere all the provisions of the above said Act, SEZ Rules 2013 and any amendments made thereof and/or rules, regulations, clarifications, directives etc, issued by the SEZ Secretariat from time to time ; and
- xiv. Processing or other fee, if any, levied by Federal BOI with the Approval of BOA shall be payable with immediate effect by the respective Developer under Rule 62(1)(b) of SEZ Rules 2013.
