Section 9(2) of the Civil Servant Act, 1973, provided that selection to such posts shall be made on the basis of merit. Subsequent to the discussion above, the Board collectively decided that she was category B officer based on her record and her demonstrated performance and conduct and awarded her 25 out of 50 marks”.

2. Further Supreme Court of Pakistan *vide* its judgement dated 11th October, 2002 in Civil Appeal No. 1599 to 1606/1999 had observed that “no Civil Servant can ask for promotion as a right.
