The Steering Committee will have the authority to make decisions that are in accordance with the objective approach and scope of the project as *set out* in the approved PC-I document.

Chairman :

- I. The Secretary, Ministry of Industries and Production, Islamabad.

Members :

- II. Chairman Export Processing Zones Authority (EPZA), Karachi.
- III. CEO, National Industrial Parks Dev. and Management Company, NIP, Karachi.
- IV. Secretary, Industries and Commerce Department, Government of Balochistan, Quetta.
- V. Managing Director, Lasbela Industrial Estates Development Authority, Hub.
- VI. Director General, Directorate of Industries and Commerce Department, Government of Balochistan, Quetta.
- VII. Representative of Industries and Commerce Section (I&C), Ministry of Planning, Development and Special Initiatives.

2. The primary objective of the Steering Committee of Hub-SEZ is to make key policy decisions, guide the Project Director & Executing Agency / Developer in the execution of the project and proper utilization of funds allocated under PSDP (Federal), to provide guideline for development of quality infrastructure in compliance of given time-line, to monitor the development works of the HUB SEZ and to direct the Executing Agency / Developer and entrepreneurs in broader way for boosting up industrialization in this region of the Province of Balochistan.

3. The Steering Committee members will be chosen for dedicated tasks in line with their ability to provide strategic leadership, make informed policy choices to exercise effective governance over the Hub-SEZ project.

A. ROLES AND FUNCTIONS :

The specific roles and functions of the Steering Committee are to :

- Provide policy guidelines to the Project Director/ Executing Agency/ Developer to establish state of the art Special Economic Zone for the industrialists.
- Oversee that all interventions/development activities under the Establishment of Hub-SEZ are in line with the approved PC-I document and the Project Director/Executing Agency/ Developer is appropriately tasked to deliver the results.
- Monitor the infrastructure development of the project by ensuring that any strategic changes are undertaken in a timely manner so that the project achieves its goals.
- Approve/ensure the proper implementation plan and yearly budget prepared by the Project Director ensuring that resources are deployed to their most productive use.
- Guide the Executing Agency in proper marketing/ promotion of the HUB SEZ for early colonization of industrial units by local/foreign investors/ Industrialists.
- Guide the Project Director/Executing Agency/ Developer for provision of required utilities like electricity and gas by K. electric and SSGCL respectively on priority basis to the industrialists.
- Support/guide the Executing Agency / Developer for preparation of PC-Is and seek funding under PSDP (Federal) for development of external infrastructure for provision of utilities like electricity and gas.
- Review and approve the recommendation for implementation of important initiatives presented by the Project Director.
- Review periodic monitoring and evaluation reports and advise the Project Director and Executing Agency/Developer accordingly.
- The Steering Committee may provide guideline for development of proper solid waste management system for the HUB SEZ.
- The Steering Committee may provide guideline to plan :
 - Establishment of Solar Power Plant for the project on BOOT basis.
 - Establishment of Desalination plan for the project on BOOT basis,

- The Steering Committee may form sub-committees and appoint technical advisors to those sub-committees, if deemed necessary, to assist in the implementation of the aforesaid project.
- May recommend revision in PC-I of the project on the basis of changes incorporated due to revision in design of the project proposed by the consultant duly recommended by the Project Director.

B. The procedure of the Steering Committee includes the following :

- The quorum for the Steering Committee shall be two-third of its members. The nominee duly authorized in writing by the member will be considered as legal representative and will be countable for making the quorum.
- The Steering Committee will aim to make decisions by consensus, in case consensus is not achieved the decision may be made by simple majority of members present and voting. In the event of a tie, the Chairman will have an additional casting vote.
- The Steering Committee is expected to meet quarterly and members will need to devote some additional time reviewing project documentations.
- The venue and schedule of the meeting shall be decided by the chair.
