- e. Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) will notify GST subsidy (*set aside* 5% GST on locally manufactured Tractors from the date of notification and up to 30th June, 2021)

- f. Government institutions/departments are not eligible for the scheme, however, agriculture research institutes would be eligible for the subsidy.

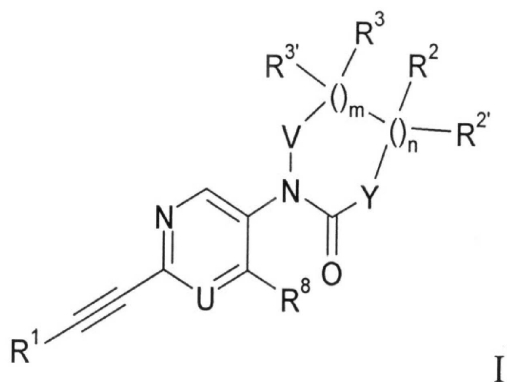

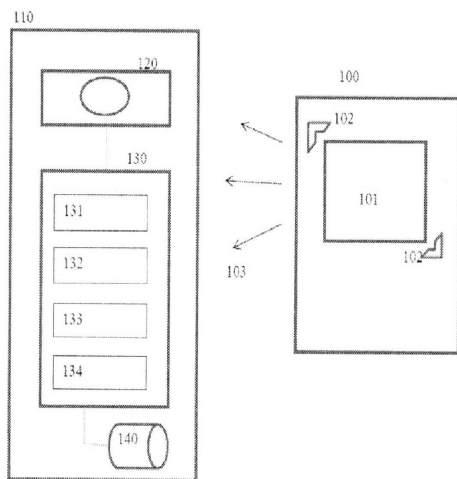

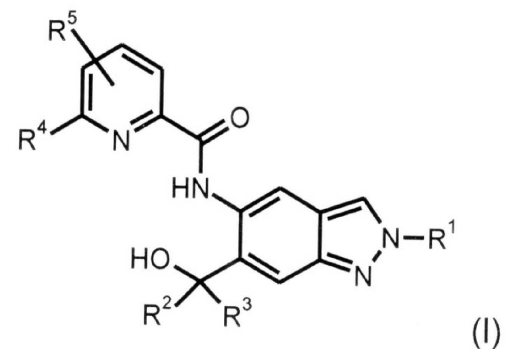

Present invention relates to the development of an isolate of Fusarium sp. (MBL-579) through chemical mutagenesis and its subsequent utilization to enhance the acidic triglycerol acyl-hydrolases potential. Furthermore, culture conditions was also optimized for mutant in comparison to the wild isolate. In the present investigation, cells of the fungal strain were subjected to nitrous acid treatment at the dose of 0.1 M for different time intervals ranging from 30-180 mm. Among all mutants tested, M-49 mutant was found to be the best producer of acidic triglycerol acyl-hydrolases with an enzyme activity of 34.83 ± 2.46^a U/mL. Among various medium tested, M4 (pH 5.4) gave the maximum acidic triglycerol acyl-hydrolases production by wild (17.86 ± 0.15^a U/mL) and mutant (35.36 ± 0.41^a U/mL) isolates. The maximum lipase activity was obtained at 35°C after 72 h of incubation at pH 6 and by using 1.5mL inoculum. Na⁺ was showed to be the best metal ion for improved production of lipase. Peptone and Ammonium nitrate (NH₄NO₃) were the best organic and inorganic nitrogen sources @ 0.6% and 0.4% concentration respectively. Dextrose was found to be the best organic carbon source @ 0.4% concentration. While soybean oil supported the maximum triglycerol acyl-hydrolases production at @ 0.8% concentration as an additional oil additive.

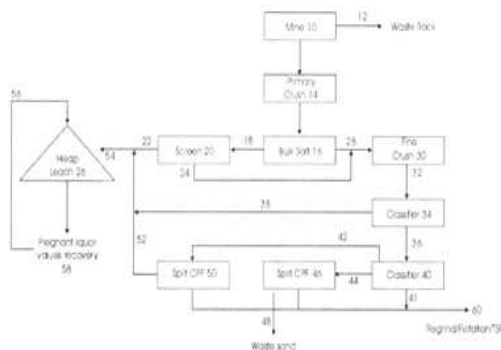

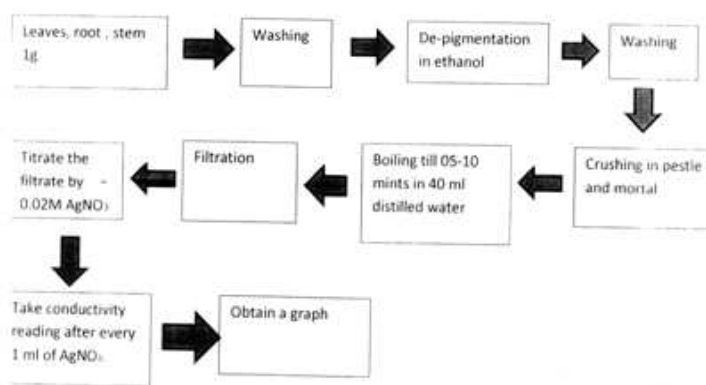
