2. The TORs of the Committee are to administer and enforce SEZ benefits and rules as well as to provide facilitation to the SEZ, its enterprises and the government with responsibilities including;

- i. Examine and approve SEZ entry application in accordance with zone admission criteria;
- ii. Provide certification of zone enterprises;
- iii. Conduct oversight of enterprises;
- iv. Enforce the building code of the SEZ;
- v. Coordinate between the developer and government entities and utility providers during construction;
- vi. Assist Zone Enterprises in obtaining approvals and registrations;
- vii. Serve as the point of contact between the zone enterprise and utility providers; and,
- viii. Facilitate between enterprises and government regulators and tax authorities.

3. Without prior approval of the SEZ Committee the Developer of the SEZ or any of its agent, sub-agent or any other third party, regardless of his relation with the Developer, shall not be entitled to sell/lease any industrial or commercial plot of sign or intend to sign an MOU or agreement or any such instrument conditionally or unconditionally to sell/lease any such plot of the SEZ, to any investor/enterprise or any other party.

4. SEZ Committee shall execute its responsibilities as per the Standard Operating Procedures in accordance with zone regulations.

- a. The purpose of forming the WG is to ensure the successful development of Ravi Riverfront Urban Development and Bundal Island City Projects (hereinafter to be referred as "Projects"). The WG will aim at supporting the Ravi Riverfront Urban Development Authority (RUDA) and The Pakistan Islands Development Authority (TPIDA) in initiating development of the two Projects in a technically, commercially and legally viable manner.
- b. The activities of the WG will be based on cooperation and on exchange of experiences. In particular, the WG shall render advice, in following areas :-
  - i. Identification of impediments leading to the successful initiation / launch of the Projects activities;
  - ii. Advise on resolution of the impediments in the most legal, effective and efficient / timely manner;

  - iv. Advise to Federal / Provincial Government and its bodies / authorities, RUDA and TPIDA on optimum technical, commercial and legal structures, revisions in laws / rules / regulations / bye-laws etc. and way forward for developing / undertaking these Projects;
  - v. Promoting Public awareness on these projects and especially attracting local and foreign investors and overseas Pakistanis; and
  - vi. Advise to Federal / Provincial Government and its bodies / authorities on any matter as may be required relating to the Projects falling in their expertise.
- c. The WG shall meet on required basis through physical and / or virtual meeting(s). First meeting of the WG has been chaired by the Prime Minister of Pakistan on Thursday, the 1st October, 2020 at PM House, Islamabad. The Chairperson may hold a meeting requiring all members to attend in person if the matter, in the opinion of the Chairperson is of such significance that effective discussion can only be made in person. The quorum of WG will be atleast three members from public sector and private sector each including the Chairperson. WG members will not be represented by alternates at the WG meeting. The Chairperson will approve the agenda for each WG meeting. Agenda will be circulated preferably

within two working days before the meeting. Minutes along with action plan will be circulated within two working days after the meeting.
