3. Whereas, the Authorized Officer, having considered the findings of the Inquiry Officer alongwith other relevant records, served the accused with a show cause notice dated 12th March, 2018 enclosing therewith the copy Inquiry Report, asking him to show cause within ten (10) days as to why one or more of the penalties including the major penalty of dismissal from service as prescribed under Rule 4(1) of Government Servants (E&D) Rules, 1973, may not be imposed upon him. He was also offered to be heard in person. However, the accused officer instead of submitting his written defense reply demanded certain documents despite the fact that he was given access to all the relevant documents during the inquiry proceedings besides affording opportunity of cross examination over the evidences against him and all the relevant documents annexed with Inquiry Report were supplied to him with the Show Cause Notice. However, in pursuance of the judgement passed by the Lahore High Court, Lahore in Writ Petition No. 199994/2018, the relevant documents demanded by him were again provided to him vide General Manager, Postal Life Insurance, Lahore memo dated 12th April, 2019. The accused officer was issued subsequent notice dated 22nd May, 2019 for submission of his written defense reply to Show Cause Notice but he failed to submit the same on one and other pretext. Therefore, after issuance of final notice dated 22nd April, 2019, he was called for personal hearing on 1st August, 2019 alongwith his written defense reply vide memo dated 19th July, 2019. However, he neither submitted his written defense reply to the show cause notice nor appeared for personal hearing on the prescribed date and time. Thus the accused was afforded a reasonable opportunity of written as well as oral defense but he failed to come up with his defense alongwith evidences to prove himself innocent rather he engaged in using delaying tactics to prolong the disciplinary proceedings on one or the other pretexts.

4. Whereas, the Authorized Officer in the light of the facts of the case, findings of the Inquiry Officer and record of disciplinary proceedings reached the final conclusion that the charges of misconduct and inefficiency in terms of Government Servants (E&D) Rules, 1973 had been established and the accused officer failed to offer any defense against these charges. The Authorized Officer, therefore, referred the case to the Authority with recommendations for imposition of major penalty upon the accused.

5. And Whereas, the Authority, after going through the facts of the case and record of disciplinary proceedings granted the accused officer personal hearing on 8th October, 2020 during which neither he could negate the charges nor could

prove himself innocent by producing evidences. Thus the charges of "Inefficiency" and "Misconduct" are established against the accused officer.
